**WHEREAS**, approximately 175,000 new cases of prostate cancer are diagnosed in men in the United States each year and over 30,000 men die each year from the disease; and


**WHEREAS**, 1 in 9 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer; and


**WHEREAS**, education regarding prostate cancer and early detection strategies are critical to saving lives and preserving and protecting our families; and




